

Centennial Pickleball Tournament

The Centennial Pickleball Tournament will be held Thursday–Sunday, March 14–17 at Pocahontas Park in historic downtown Vero Beach. If you are a fan of playing Pickleball, tournament organizers are urging all area players to register now before the cap amount is filled! If you are a fan of watching great Pickleball, this is the one to visit as a spectator.

As of this writing, 400 registrations have been accepted and the cap is 600 players. The four-day tournament is drawing participants from all over Florida plus from four states outside Florida. Thursday and Friday, March 14 and 15, will be for seniors age 60 and above; Level play from 2.5 to 4.5 playing men’s and women’s double, mixed play and singles. Saturday and Sunday, March 16 and March 17 will be from age 10 to 50’s in age division and skill level will be from 2.5 to Professional in singles, doubles and mixed. The Pros will be having a clinic on Wednesday, March 13 for those participants that would like to learn shots.

Have you heard the news? Kyle Yates is participating! If you haven't seen him play, mark your calendar. Go to Pocahontas Park and squeeze in among the crowd. Undoubtedly many Picklers in the area will want to watch this pro. He's fast, talented, and amazing!
