

## A Centennial Event....Waldo's Flag Ceremony and Time Capsule

The community is invited to this very historic event. In recognition of the City Centennial a horse-drawn carriage will deliver a Time Capsule filled with photographs and a myriad of artifacts to Waldo's Restaurant at The Driftwood on Ocean Drive on Saturday, October 27, 2018 at 9:30am to 10:30am. It will be planted in the ground at the foot of the newly purchased flag and flag pole in front of the Oceanside restaurant. The celebration will include a showing of antique cars and a musical performance by the Charter High School Band.

The flag to be raised on the newly erected flagpole, as a special request by City Councilman Tony Young, co-chair of the Centennial, was flown over our Nation's Capitol this past spring on the very day Vero Beach was founded in 1919. Now this special flag will be flown for the first time at the Driftwood. After 10 days it will be placed in a flag case and displayed in the lobby of the restaurant.
